## GET READY FOR THE SECOND KKNK YOUTH ARTS FESTIVAL IN 2024!

An unforgettable three-day arts adventure.

**Following the success of the very first KKNK Youth Arts Festival in 2023, we are excited to present it for a second time from 25 to 27 March 2024!** This initiative is presented in collaboration with the Western Cape Education Department (WCED).

One of the core goals of the KKNK is to expand the impact of the arts and in doing so, making it more sustainable. And what better way to achieve this goal than by developing the audiences of the future and to establish a love for the arts amongst the youth at an early age?

By exposing the youth to the arts, young audiences are cultivated who will not only respond to the future artistic and socio-economic needs of our province, but also the rest of South Africa.”

The programme includes theatre, music, dance, visual arts and more, in the form of professional productions, discussions and workshops – presented in the heart of the Klein Karoo. Here the arts are celebrated, whilst new friendships are formed. An informal process is included in 2024 where learners can showcase their interpretation of their personal growth, experiences, or insights at the festival, in the form of a performance, installation, or visual arts exhibition.

**High schools and groups that are interested, must contact the KKNK by 15 January 2024** to make a provisional booking, but **the final closing date for registration is 1 March 2024**. Take note that participants are responsible for their own transport to and from Oudtshoorn, as well as in town during the festival. Limited accommodation is available at the festival and schools, groups and parents are encouraged to make bookings at 044 203 8600 as soon as possible.

## RULES

**Excellence:** I accept that the KKNK invests in outstanding creativity and strives towards excellence.

**Integrity:** I am committed to promoting transparency, respect, and accountability.

**Accessibility:** I accept the KKNK's efforts towards accessibility of the arts and in Afrikaans, amongst diverse artists and audiences.

**Leadership:** I will rise above my circumstances and be part of a successful South Africa.

I take note of the following rules:

1. All learners staying in hostels must be quiet in their rooms from 23:00.
2. No learner may be in possession of any cigarettes, drugs, or alcohol.
3. The supervising adult is the learner's contact person and supervisor. Any incidents must be reported to the programme leader immediately.
4. At the KKNK Youth Arts Festival's venues, you are not allowed to:
  - 4.1. Climb onto any tents, construction, fences, lights, bridges, benches, or any other structures on the terrain.
  - 4.2. Block any entrances, exits and/or emergency exits.
  - 4.3. Throw or shoot any objects in a solid, liquid, or gaseous form.
  - 4.4. Smoke.
  - 4.5. Urinate and/or defecate in public.
5. This list only provides an overview as a guideline, but if any learner is found to be behaving in a manner that the KKNK does not allow, the KKNK reserves the right to remove the learner, or to hand them over to the police.
6. The wearing of texts, symbols, objects, clothes and/or other (visible) external expressions that expressly represent a political, social movement or group is prohibited. Anything that implies discrimination, hate speech, incitement or racism is strictly prohibited.
7. The following is allowed:
  - 7.1. Guide dogs if required.
  - 7.2. Disposable or compact cameras.
8. The following objects are not allowed:
  - 8.1. Firearms, ammunition, explosives, knives or any sharp or pointed metal object that can be considered a dangerous weapon.
  - 8.2. Any dangerous weapon as described in Article 1 of the Dangerous Weapons Act No. 63 of 1968.
  - 8.3. Teargas, foil, or similar chemical agents as mentioned in Article 1 of the Tear-gas Act No. 16 of 1964 or similar chemical or organic agents in the air such as pepper spray.



- 8.4. Narcotics or other mind-altering substances (except those prescribed by a registered medical practitioner).
- 8.5. Animals (except guide dogs).
- 8.6. Banners or flags of which the content may reasonably be considered vulgar, racist, sexist, discriminatory, inflammatory and/or offensive.
- 8.7. Any chemical that can reasonably be considered dangerous.
- 8.8. Any device or object that could be considered disruptive in any way.
- 9. The KKNK has a zero tolerance towards drugs.

**LIST OF NECESSITIES**

- 1. Festival clothing: comfortable shoes to walk in or takkies, a water bottle and sunscreen.
- 2. Personal medication like asthma inhalers, painkillers for headaches, remedies for nausea and allergic reactions, like for bee stings etc.
- 3. Personal toiletries.
- 4. OPTIONAL: Any music instruments that can be transported, like a guitar or flute.
